The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ
"Corpus Christi Sunday"
Father's Day
June 18, 2017

"The Eucharist is the heart and the summit of the Church's life." (CCC 1407)

Today we celebrate Corpus Christi, or The Body of Christ. The Eucharist is the center of our faith as Catholic Christians. In the Gospel, Christ tells us how to have eternal life: He gives us His body and His blood. In the Old Testament, the Israelites complained to Moses, and were given manna to eat in the desert. This manna came down from heaven, but those that ate the manna, eventually, still died. Christ, however, offers Himself as the Bread of Life. He promises that His body and blood give us eternal life.

In today's Old Testament reading, the manna was not given to the Israelites to satisfy their hunger. Instead, it was given to them so that they could understand that man does not live by bread alone, but by the Word of God. Jesus is the Word, who came down from heaven. Eternal life is offered to us, but it is only through Him that we have eternal life. To know God, we must know the Word. To know Jesus, we must spend time getting to know Holy Scripture, which is the inspired Word of God.

Through the Eucharist, we become one with Christ. This is a gift given to us because God loves us so much that he wants us to be united with Him. St. Paul tells us in the second reading today that the Eucharist is a participation in Christ's body and blood. In turn, we each participate with each other. Each one of us is united to one another, and we, together, form the Body of Christ. Each and every one of us makes up the Body of Christ. Therefore, each one of us is special, an important member of the Body of Christ. As such, we all share in the same Eucharist. As we gather together today, even though each one of us has special intentions that we pray for, remember that we are praying for each other.
