August 6, 2017

“Listen to Him”

In Today’s Gospel the three disciples followed Jesus up a mountain. They could not know what wonders awaited them. This event was to transform and strengthen their faith and ours. They saw the glory of Jesus and they received their mandate from the Heavenly Father to Listen to Jesus, His beloved Son. On the way down, Jesus predicted his death and resurrection. These once simple fishermen were changed to strong faith filled apostles who listened to Jesus and did what He said.

In the second reading, we have the powerful words of Peter urging us to be attentive to his message. He strongly states, “We have been eyewitnesses of his majesty. We ourselves heard this voice from heaven while we were with him on the holy mountain.”

God calls all disciples to listen to his Son’s teaching. We are also called to follow the prompting of the Holy Spirit. I’d like to share a story from my own life that happened years ago. I was a new lay minister of Holy Communion. We had finished the Training, I know the Procedures and Rules.

One day, my husband and I were out in a very rural part of our community. We had just finished serving the last person on our list. This person was an elderly lady who then insisted that we go to her neighbor who was very sick. She wanted us to go right then. As we got to the car, I said that I wasn’t even sure we could find the place. My husband said, “I can find it” and he did. I knocked on the porch door and when someone came to the door, I explained who we were and why we were there. The person said, “We called the Church days ago and we’ve been waiting and waiting, where were you! Then, “I’m sorry, please come in.” We met everyone, began the prayers, my husband gave Holy Communion to the very sick lady. As we left, I reflected on the smiles, joy and peace we left behind. After that, her condition was such that she no longer could take Holy Communion.

We had given her what the church calls Holy Viaticum, which is the last communion you take with you to eternity. This is an example of how God leads and guides us all if we listen to Him.

May God’s peace be with each of you today and always.

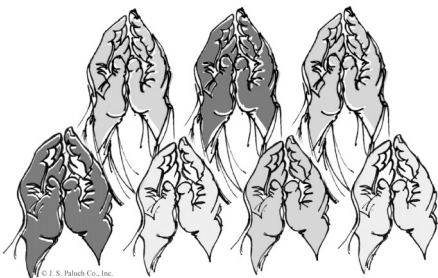
