Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time
October 22, 2017

I am a very fortunate woman. I once described myself as interested in and good at a lot of different things, but not really outstanding in any one thing. I like to sing and I'm ok at it, but I would probably not get to round one in America's Got Talent. I can read music, thanks to my childhood education, but I couldn't compose a song if you paid me. I've been known to repair and mend clothes and can even make myself or someone else a garment, but I couldn't design it. I can cook, actually I love to cook, but I'm not a chef. I love to read, but I couldn't write a book. I like sports, and when I was younger, I played women's fast-pitch softball and competitive volleyball, but I didn't get signed on to any Major League team! Back when I was working as a Registered Nurse, I've got to admit, I was a great nurse; I loved my job, working with patients and trying to make their experience in my clinical care as easy as possible was a joy.

Our readings today are filled with a reminder that we should give to the Lord. From the Responsorial Psalm - we should: "give the Lord glory and honor... glory and praise... the glory due his name! Bring gifts, and enter his courts." From the second reading: "...give thanks to God always...", and from the Gospel: "Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God."

I invite you to take a moment and think about what talent, ability or treasure it is that you have.

In describing myself above, I didn't talk about what a great marriage I have and how fortunate it is that I have a loving husband and wonderful children. 


