

First Sunday of Lent
March 3, 2019

We heard on Ash Wednesday. “Even now, says the Lord, return to me with your whole heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning..”. What a fitting way to begin our Lenten journey – giving our whole heart to the Lord. I’m not advocating weeping and mourning because there is loss, but I am saying, that we can be happy and weep while coming to a whole new realization about our journey to God; improve and mourn while realizing that we too can be forgiven and start anew.

I’ve wondered pretty much wondered all my life why it was that Jesus was tempted by the devil. He is God! Is the devil that stupid? Well yes, he is. And he’s tricky and conniving and takes advantage of any opening that presents itself. Sometimes even during times that we wouldn’t recognize; he strikes while we are at our weakest. He strikes with what he thinks would be the most successful strategy.

This was the case with Jesus. Like us, He is human and because He became man, must undertake all of our conditions. He was born of woman, grew as any child does, learned obedience at his Mother’s knee, acquired a trade, and then eventually began His ministry. He was presented with 3 temptations: **Selfishness** – take care of yourself – turn this stone into bread, **Power** – over all without regard of others and who we might hurt – power and glory are mine to give, **Pride** – I can do anything without consequence – the angels will save you.

When are we at our weakest? What are our temptations? Like Jesus, we too are tempted by Selfishness, Power and Pride. I’m sure it doesn’t look like what Jesus was presented with, but none-the-less, it is the same. This is why Jesus was tempted, to show us the way and how we too can overcome the devil.

My brothers and sisters, this Lent, I pray that we all return to the Lord with our whole heart.





San Jose Mission Church in Luis Lopez is selling memorial bricks in order to raise funds for a heating and cooling system and other repairs at the church.


The bricks are \$100 each for a maximum of three lines with thirteen characters on each line.


