

Solemnity of Pentecost  
June 9, 2019

Brothers and Sisters,

This weekend we are celebrating the birthday of the church. Yesterday, Saturday, I laid my mother to rest. A birth and a death... that's life isn't it?

How must the apostles, the women and all the followers of Jesus who gathered in that Upper Room or in their own homes have felt? They saw their beloved leader whipped, tortured and die. Then came the sightings and news of his resurrection. We had Thomas with his famous words proclaim that unless he could put his fingers into the holes of his hands and side that he would not believe! And yet in the end, they all believed! I am so grateful for their belief! I am grateful for their dedication to their mission, for they went forth renewed with the gift of the Holy Spirit: "... Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them..."

He breathed on them. The breath of life is a gift, how much more is the breath of the Holy Spirit? Is that gift still alive and well in you? How do you live the Pentecost, the mission of the church – what is the meaning, purpose and fulfillment of your life? I will forever see in her the Pentecost.

The Medical Missionaries of Mary wrote to thank us for our donations to Casa Visitation in Honduras:

In January they wrote that our donation assisted a support group for victims of domestic violence. They tell of Esperanza and her family who were able to free themselves from an abusive situation and now live happily in safety.

In April they wrote that because of our support they are able to help elderly people who are in the streets, alone and abandoned. They tell of Abuela Olympia who is 96 years old and destitute with no family to care for her. Because of donations like ours, the sisters are able help her with food, medicines and a listening ear.


