Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ
Corpus Christi
June 23, 2019

All of us form the Church. Who is the founder of the Church? The founder is our Savior Jesus Christ. How is Jesus most present to us? It is in the Blessed Sacrament. Today's celebration of Corpus Christi, the Body of Christ is the feast of the very center and heart of our church, the center of our faith. It is the center and heart of the lives of each of us, Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.


I know that some find it difficult to believe simple bread and simple wine change into the Body and Blood of Jesus. We don't see any change in the bread or wine. There is no difference in the texture or taste. This seems illogical.

I think the problem stems from the word change. As human beings a change in anything is noticeable. I can change my clothes, or my hair style (doubtful), or my attitude, and that change is noticeable. Our weather can change and we will notice that. We might search for a change in scenery. When we have a change of jobs, or a change in address there are great differences from one thing to another.

Maybe we need to humble ourselves to add faith to our intellect and reason, to admit that intellect by itself does not provide all the answers, and that God can perform miracles every day making it possible for bread and wine to become the Body and Blood of Jesus while keeping the same appearance. When we submit to God we will not lose anything, we will gain everything. There is a beautiful chant, "Trust, surrender, believe, receive." If we add faith to our reasoning and receive the love of God the Eucharist is real.



In January they wrote that our donation assisted a support
group for victims of domestic violence. They tell of
Esperanza and her family who were able to free
themselves from an abusive situation and now live
happily in safety.

In April they wrote that because of our support they are able
to help elderly people who are in the streets, alone and
abandoned. They tell of Abuela Olympia who is 96 years
old and destitute with no family to care for her. Because
of donations like ours, the sisters are able help her with
food, medicines and a listening ear.


