

From the Desk of.....Ann Hook
Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
August 11, 2019

This week's readings speak to us of faith, especially the faith we are called to have as followers of Christ. Reflecting on these readings, my mind moved to the children of our community who start school this week. I thought of the connection between faith and raising children. I thought of my three daughters and how I felt as each one began kindergarten, high school, and college. They were leaving the close supervision of home and entering a world where they would experience varied influences. To let go required faith in them. A spiritual maxim tells us to "work as if everything depends upon me and pray as if everything depends upon God." As parents, grandparents and Godparents we work hard to protect, nurture, and guide our children. As the school year draws near, I would like to share a prayer with you that I found comforting when my daughters were teenagers. I prayed it very often during those formative years.

A Parent's Prayer for the Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Loving Spirit of God, in behalf of myself and my child I ask you for:

The Wisdom to perceive the way you are leading my child that I may not hinder you;

The Understanding to fathom the workings of my child's mind so that my judgements will not be harsh but gentle;

The Counsel to give guidance in the right amount, the right way at the right moment;

The Piety that makes me a Christian inside and out so that I never preach what I do not live;

The Fortitude to weather the storms and doubts that assail my own spirit and to be a source of strength and courage to my child;

The Fear of you, Lord, that is not terror but awe and reverence in sharing with You in the creation of another human life for time and eternity;

Heavenly Father, help me to deal with my child in the same spirit I want You to deal with me.


