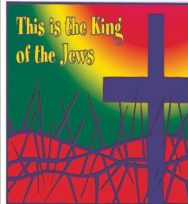

The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ,  
King of the Universe  
November 24, 2019

How fitting that the Roman Catholic Church concludes the end of our Liturgical Year with so great a solemnity. Today's three readings speak to us about kingship.

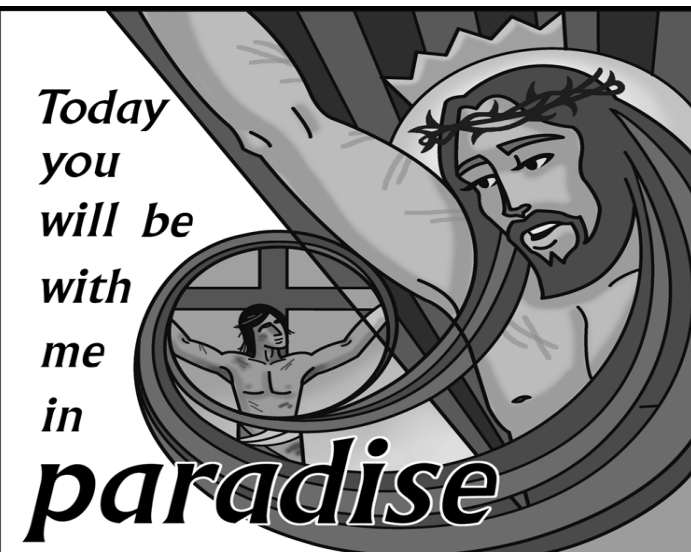
Our first reading from the second book of Samuel, we hear of the elders from the tribes of Israel anointing David as King of all Israel. Did you know that David had been anointed two other times prior to 2 Samuel 5:1-3? The first took place in 1 Samuel 16:13, where David receives his first anointing from Samuel after Jessie, David's father, had presented all his other sons who weren't the chosen one of the Lord. The second takes place in 2 Samuel 2:4, after many successful battles David had while fighting for King Saul. The people anoint David as King of Hebron. Later in 2 Samuel 12:13, the prophet Nathan tells David that one his offspring would establish his Kingdom and that this royal throne would last forever. We know that Nathan was speaking of Jesus, a descendant in the line of David.

In Colossians 1:13, St. Paul reminds them and us that the Father has delivered us from the power of darkness and transferred us to the Kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. We need to remember that Jesus is the Head of the body, the Church, and we are all part of that body.

Our Gospel today from Luke is speaking about the crucifixion of Jesus. We see that even Pilate must have had an idea that Jesus was truly a King, having had a sign nailed to the Cross with the inscription "This is the King of the Jews." It appears that one of the men crucified with our Lord must have believed that Jesus was a King, as he rebuked the other man for reviling Jesus. He then asks Jesus to remember him when he comes to His kingdom. Jesus' response, "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

We all hope to hear these words from our Lord, when we stand before Him. The words from Matt 25:21, "Well done my good and faithful servant. Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities. Come, share your master's joy."

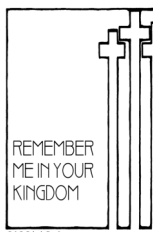
