Second Sunday of Easter
(Divine Mercy Sunday)
April 19, 2020

Al anochecer del día de la resurrección, estando cerradas las puertas donde se hallaban los discípulos, se presentó Jesús en medio de ellos. Les mostro las manos y el costado. Cuando los discípulos vieron al Señor se llenaron de alegría. Tomas, uno de ellos, no estaba con ellos cuando vino Jesús, y los otros discípulos le decían, "Hemos visto al Señor". Pero el les contesto: "Si no veo sus heridas en sus manos y en su costado no creeré." Días después, estaban reunidos los discípulos y Tomas estaba con ellos. ¿Por qué es, que volvió una semana después al mismo lugar exacto? Quizás porque esta vez Tomas estaba allí, y Jesús quería convencer a este discípulo tan incrédulo que el verdaderamente había resucitado.

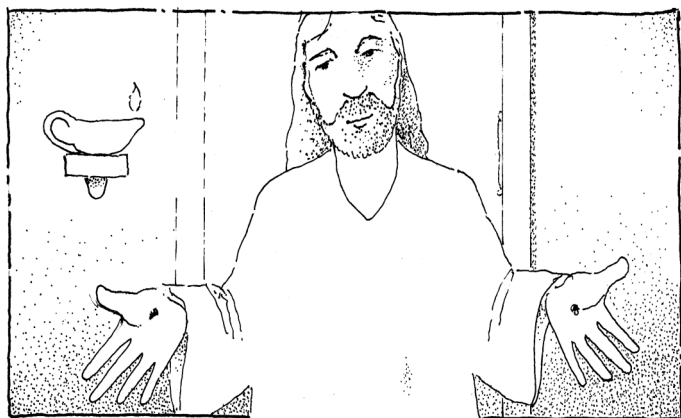
Luego Jesús le dijo a Tomas, "Aquí están mis manos, acerca tu dedo. Trae acá tu mano y métela en mi costado y no sigas dudando, sino cree". Tomas le respondió, "¡Señor mío y Dios mío!" Jesús añadió, "Tú crees porque me has visto, dichosos los que creen sin haber visto".

Y este acto de compasión y paciencia –ese acto de misericordia– guio a Tomas a que proclamara "¡Mi Señor y me Dios! Con el tiempo, esa misericordia dirigió a Tomas a que viajara lejos y por todo lugar a proclamar el evangelio y, en el final dar su vida por su Señor.

La historia de Tomas nos enseña que la misericordia de Dios envuelve más que el perdón de nuestros pecados, que es algo muy grande. 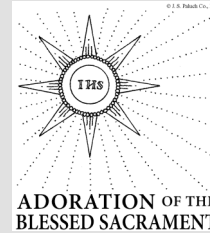
