Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ
(Corpus Christi Sunday) - June 14, 2020

A Reflection on the Feast of Corpus Christi

In the early thirteenth century, Sister (later Saint) Juliana of Liege, had a recurring vision of a full moon surrounded by a black band. She did not understand its meaning but in time, she heard Christ tell her that the moon signified the Church's calendar and the black band indicated the lack of a feast to honor His Body and Blood. During her lifetime, Sister Juliana struggled to have a feast established in honor of the Body and Blood of Christ and in 1264, six years after her death, Pope Urban VI placed the Feast of Corpus Christi on the universal church calendar.

This year the Feast of Corpus Christi takes on a deeper meaning for me. For nine weeks it has not been possible to receive the Eucharist, due to Covid-19. Like the Israelites in the first reading, I became hungry. However, "*God never misses a chance to help us grow...*" (Richard Rohr, OFM) and this year provides such an opportunity. I reflect on the areas of the world that lack priests and, therefore, do not have access to the Eucharist. This year becomes an opportunity to share, in a small way, their experience, to be in solidarity with them. These reflections lead me to deeper gratitude for Father John, who far from his family during this time of uncertainty, cares for our spiritual needs.

So, today, as it has been done for more than seven hundred years, the Feast of Corpus Christi is celebrated and this year I do so with renewed relish because of my "time of hunger." The change in having to receive Communion upon exiting Mass makes it no less a sacred moment. Outside the church, we have as much time as we desire to fully appreciate the wonder and mystery we have received and to remember, "*When we receive Christ with interior devotion, his blood, full of warmth and glory, flows into our veins and a fire is kindled in our depths. We receive the likeness of his virtues, and he lives in us and we in him.*" ~Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity.

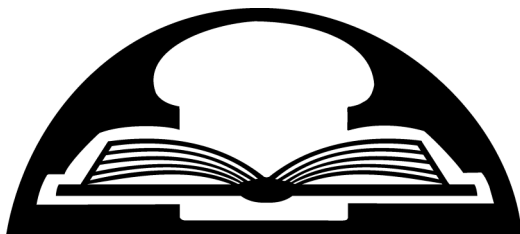

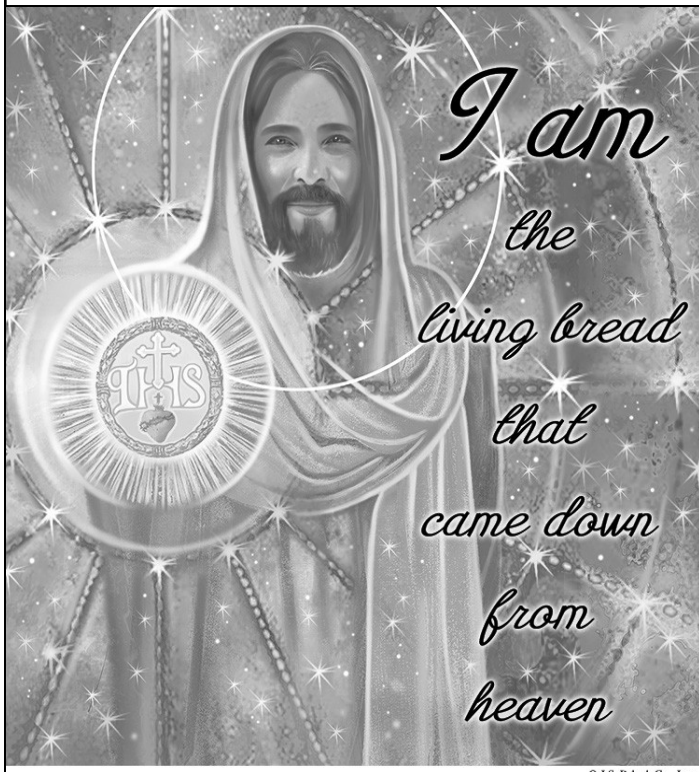
**The San Miguel Cemetery Walk in Gates
